### Notes:

Section 72 (1) of the Legal Profession Regulation 2007 states that money on deposit with the law society in a statutory deposit account is repayable on demand to the law practice that deposited the money.

Please note that pursuant to section 72(2) of the Regulations, a law practice must not make a demand for repayment of money under subsection (1) unless repayment of the money is required to enable necessary payments to be made out of the general trust account of the law practice and there are reasonable grounds for believing that the payments needs to be made within 7 days of the request being made.

Payments are processed by EFT generally within 24 – 48 hours of receiving the refund request.
